

Watercolor Supply List

Hi, artist-to-be!

This is your supply list for the Beginning Watercolor Class. I picked a mid-level priced set of supplies because I want you to be happy with your painting without spending a fortune!

You can purchase these supplies from Michaels or Hobby Lobby, but sometimes they don't have everything, so I recommend ordering from Cheap Joe's Art Stuff. They will be shipped to you directly. Their number is 800-227-2788.

List:

Paint – 15 ml tubes of Winsor & Newton Lemon Yellow, Permanent Rose and Winsor Blue (R.S.). Useful, but optional – Burnet Sienna, Sap Green and Sepia.

Brushes – one #8 round and one 1" flat. If you use Cheap Joe's the brushes are called Miller's Old Faithful. Otherwise, choose brushes that are half natural bristle and half synthetic fibers and are in a mid-price range.

Palette – any palette that holds 20 or so colors and is plastic with a lid. You will put dabs of paint in the depressions in the palette.

Water container – one half gallon plastic ice cream bucket or similar sized container.

Paper – 11" X 15" Watercolor paper in a pad, 30 sheets, weight 140#, this can be found at Walmart.
